Matters for report

- VIA have advised that in regards to additional lighting on College Street, upgrade works have taken place and were deemed to be the most effective solution. There will be no more additional works at this time.
- The hedge has been cut back on the corner of Main Road and College Street
- The Diocese have responded regarding the usage of both gates and mud on the road, the Diocese comments have been circulated
- The Streetlight at Butt Field/School/Scout area has been fixed
- The new PSPO dog signs on the play area that were torn down and have now been replaced
- The contract for the grounds maintenance and litter picking has been accepted.
- VIA have confirmed that they will carry out soil / seeding works in the spring on the Kneeton Road Verges.
- Pre-planning advice for the tennis club has been received and circulated.
